



4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)




154 articles published in 2016.

Note: JGO is published quarterly from 2010 to 2013 and has been a bi-monthly journal since 2014.




6. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2016



In 2016, JGO has published 154 manuscripts. Among them, there are 81 original articles and 35 review articles.




7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2016

8. Free Submissions in 2016




The total number of free submissions to JGO in 2016 is 207. The rejection rate is 51%.

9. Citations in 2016 (results by month)




The number of total citation has significantly increased to 1,761 in 2016.

10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2016




Retrieval of JGO in PubMed is increasing significantly, with a total of 455,020 times in 2016.


11. Page Views of JGO Website in 2016
