



4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)




142 articles are published in 2017.

Note: JGO is published quarterly from 2010 to 2013 and has been a bi-monthly journal since 2014.




6. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2017



Among the 142 manuscripts, there are 82 original articles and 31 review articles.




7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2017




Corresponding authors of 142 articles in 2017 come from 22 countries, with 67% of them from USA.



8. Free Submissions in 2017






The total number of free submissions to JGO in 2017 is 216. The rejection rate is 48.6%.

9. Citations in 2017 (results by year)




The number of total citation has significantly increased to 3,174 in 2017.

10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2017




Retrieval of JGO in PubMed is increasing significantly, with a total of 560,009 times in 2017.
